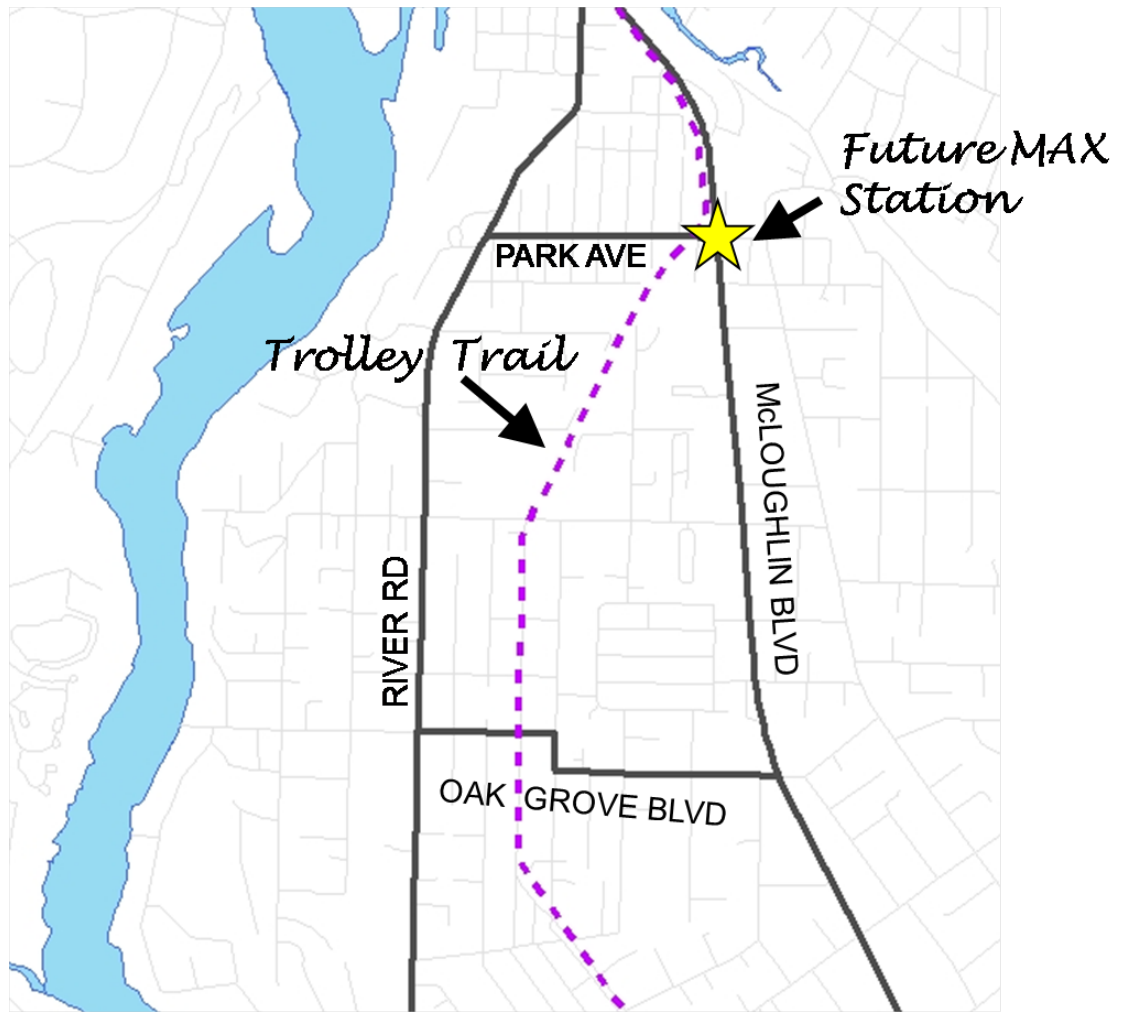

Oak Grove Neighborhood Center Plan

The information gathered at the workshop will be incorporated into the Oak Grove Neighborhood Center Plan that is being developed by Foothill Planning Associates. Foothill Planning is a group of Portland State University students in the Master of Urban & Regional Planning program.

The Neighborhood Center Plan aims to harness future public and private investments to enhance the livability and sustainability of Oak Grove. The plan will look at historic Oak Grove Boulevard and connections to the planned light rail station at Park Avenue via the Trolley Trail and McLoughlin Boulevard. Recommendations for transportation, land use and environmental improvements will be made.
